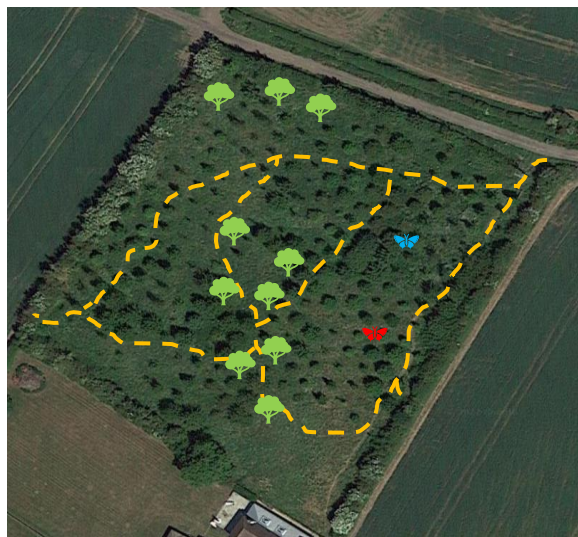
The Copse is now in need of its annual winter tidy up.
